# Spring Clean Checklist

Apply fresh pine straw or natural cypress mulch.

Per our covenants, dyed materials (including red mulch)

must not be used.

Remove weeds, rubbish, trash, debris, garbage, plastic and other unsightly materials.

Prune and trim trees, hedges and shrubbery.

Ensure recreational (including pool), maintenance equipment and building materials are kept from view.

Remove all yard signs (a single 6" x 6" security sign is permitted). *Yard signs, including contractor signage are not permitted year round.*
