Our aim was to ensure the measures did not negatively impact our access in and out of the neighborhood, hence speed humps were ruled out.

After careful consideration signage options and placement, for which I must give thanks to Eileen Barrs, I am pleased to say the new signs have now been installed at two locations in the neighborhood. One is located at the front entrance (angled slightly so that it is faces traffic as they turn left into our street), and the other is located as you turn left onto Gaines Ridge Rd.
